

## **ICCL VARSITY (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>) BASEBALL**

### **2023-ICCL-BASEBALL PLAYING RULES and REGULATIONS**

**HOME TEAMS** are to be determined by the flip of a coin prior to the start of the game and the home team is responsible to keep the official score. **NOTE: no need to wait for an umpire to flip. As soon as there are representatives from each team you may have the coin flip.** If two teams meet more than one time during the regular season, they will switch home and away. Post season reverts back to a coin flip.

**Baseballs for Games:** Both teams should plan on supplying one new baseball and one slightly used baseball for each game. ICCL game balls are Wilson A1010 blems.

Scheduled games **should not be postponed** unless there is inclement weather; postponed games due to other causes, (certain school/parish activities) must have the approval of the ICCL Baseball Commissioner, or the League President.

The League will provide the umpire(s) for all scheduled games. If a game is postponed, due to weather it may not be rescheduled. **The ICCL will try to reschedule all rain outs.** Postponed games will be rescheduled as soon as possible.

**Protest and Player Eligibility Rules:** The ICCL Constitution provides for a **NO PROTEST-RULE**, the decision of the umpire(s) is final. The only protest allowed by the League involves player eligibility. Players and coaches guilty of misconduct are subject to League penalties.

Rosters are required to be returned to the Baseball Commissioner prior to April 26th, 2021, signed by the school principal or parish pastor. Send to John Krzyzewski, 61431 Alexander Street, Vandalia, Michigan 49095 or e-mail to Revski5@aol.com. **Failure to submit the rosters by the due date will result in forfeiture of the next scheduled game.**

It shall be the responsibility of the **winning coach** to turn in the score within 24 hours. It is requested that the reporting of scores should be completed before the end of each week so that the standings can be kept up to date. Scores can be posted on the ICCL website by going to **sports, baseball, then to communications**, which will bring up the schedule, go to your game and enter the info, it will turn red. After this happens, it just needs final approval before it goes to the website.
